## **FOREWORD**



## **ADMISSION CRITERIA**

## For Diploma in Nursing Science & Midwifery (3 years)/For Diploma in Midwifery (3 years)

The applicants must have passed both their SSC and HSC examinations from any discipline (science/arts/commerce) and must obtain a combined GPA of 6. However, GPA less than 2.5 in any of the exam is not accepted. In addition to that, they will have to sit for the GoB admission test and shall have to obtain a pass mark. Only the selected students through this process can apply to GCCN.

### For B.Sc in Nursing (Basic)

The applicants must have passed both their SSC and HSC examinations from Science background with biology compulsory and must obtain a total of GPA 7. GPA less than 3.00 in any of these exams (SSC and HSC) is not accepted and obtaining GPA 3.00 in biology in both the examinations is necessary. Furthermore, the applicant will have to sit for the GoB admission test and have to obtain a pass mark to apply to GCCN. Only the selected students can apply in GCCN.

### For B.Sc in Nursing (Post Basic)

Students who have completed their Diploma in Nursing course successfully, can apply for 2 years B.Sc. in Nursing (post basic nursing) course. Such eligible candidates will have to sit for a GoB admission test and obtain pass mark.

# For M.Sc in Nursing (Nursing Education, Community Health Nursing, Adult & Elderly Health Nursing, Nursing Management, Women's Health & Midwifery)

Applicants must have passed Bachelor of Science in Nursing or Bachelor of Science in Midwifery from any nursing college recognized by BNMC, with at least 2 years of clinical experience and updated BNMC registration.

## **INFRASTRUCTURES**

#### Classroom

GCCN is committed to ensuring an exciting learning and recreational environment in our college. We offer a modern, quiet and tidy campus with high standard classrooms. There are a total of 14 classrooms (7 small and 7 large) in GCCN. Well-furnished, spacious classrooms equipped with the latest teaching aids like multimedia projectors are available to have highly interactive and useful sessions in classroom teaching. All classrooms are well-illuminated, properly ventilated, have modern sitting arrangement, and equipped with Air Conditioning and sound system.

#### Lab

In GCCN, students get a special opportunity to use various kinds of lab facilities to develop

their skills and competencies. Students are taken to the lab practice after finishing their theory classes in each topic so that they become capable of developing both their theoretical and practical knowledge very strongly. #### Library

GCCN has a large library where a huge number of students can study at a time. This library is well equipped with modern technology like e-library, national and international books, journals, health related books etc. Students can borrow books from the library as well as they can also use the library materials online. The library facilitates a silent and cool environment to study attentively.





### E-library

GCCN has launched an e-library for its students & faculty members. Other visitors can request temporary guest Wi-Fi access on e-library's device at the Help Desk. There are laptop/desktop clusters in the library for faculties and students. All users will have access to any of their devices too.

### **Dormitory**

GCCN provides a 9 storied building for the female students with fully furnished rooms, large dining, indoor-outdoor gaming, prayer room, common rooms, sick/isolation rooms, and TV room facilities. This hostel has a total 154 rooms with the capacity of 700 students. GCCN also provides residential facilities for the foreign teachers/visitors and students in this hostel. Housemothers are taking care of daily needs and security of the students round the clock. In addition to that a standard safety and security system is highly maintained by the authority. Everyday 3 meals considering nutritional value are provided in a big 200 seat capacity dining hall on the ground floor of the hostel.


